Our curriculum is based upon the belief that children learn through creative and engaging experiences to secure the development of knowledge.

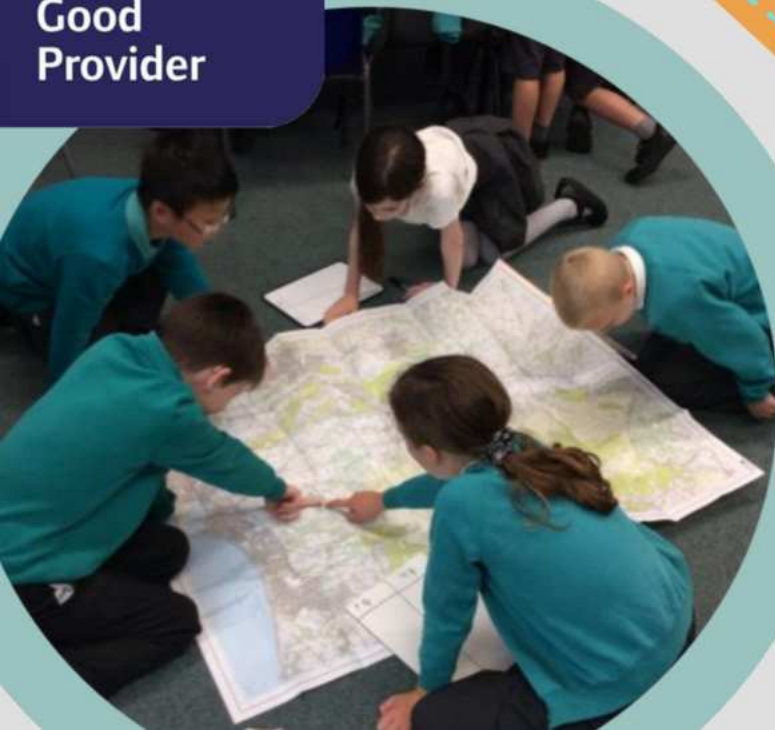

What makes it so special?

The Early Years Foundation stage follows a distinct and separate curriculum to the rest of your child's time at school. They will learn through play and be encouraged to develop their curiosity and problem solving skills in an environment specially designed for early childhood development.
